



Returning to Riding during Covid 19 Pandemic

'Thank you for bearing with us during these difficult times'

From 22nd June we will be offering 30 minute Private and semi Private lessons on the flat. Price will remain the same to allow for the extra cleaning and preparation method required.

In order to return Clients must be able to:-

- Capable of riding in the outdoor arenas
- Receive the horse from tie up station and untie & return horse/pony to its tie up station
- Remove reins from throat lash
- Tighten girth & adjust stirrups
- Mount horse/pony un – aided
- Be competent at trotting on a range of horse/ponies without help
- Provide own equipment (gloves to be worn at all times)
- Only one spectator may attend (others to remain in the car)

For the safety of yourself and others:-

- All clients must remain in their car until 5 minutes before their lesson. They must proceed to the outdoor arena. They must not enter any stables or barns nor touch any of the horses. Please ensure that you arrive at the arena with your full PPE equipment as we cannot provide hats, whips etc
- Only the toilet in the top office is available for client use and it must be wiped down after use
- To ensure safety of our staff and clients the tack will be wiped down after use. In addition social distancing will be in place and other measures imposed by the government guidelines
- In the event of an accident the instructor will attend the causality wearing a mask and gloves and will ask the causality to put on a mask before injury assessment can take place
- All clients Must complete a rider consent form which can be printed from Face Book or emailed to the participant
- Payment can be made via BACS or cash in a sealed envelope
